Understanding the now?

- * Political upheaval – next 3 to 5 years – or beyond....
- * Crisis borne engagement in domestic policy
- * Changing communities – Working age and Very Ill
- * Framing of care – Carillion factor
- * Formal workforce skill and volume shortages



What will the future models of housing & care look like in 10 years?

- * Technology will dominate all aspects of care provision
- * Robotics will be a central tenant of delivery – both frontline and in the build and design of services
Funding will incentivise prevention
- * Buildings will be multi-purpose and serve community – environmental considerations plus modularity
- * Residential will cater for transience as well as permanence



What will the future workforce in housing and care want in 10 years?

- * Professional standing – higher up the hierarchy
- * Connection to social justice
- * Tech ready workplace
- * Autonomy
- * Community identification transformed – virtual dominance



What will the future consumers of housing and care want in 10 years?

- * Intergenerational – non ghettoized
- * Fully integrated health, housing and care
- * Smart self managed systems – nothing about me without me
- * Person controlled – not centred
- * Fits me – my culture, my community, my interests, my values
